1.1	Origins	The Ultimate Keeper League (UKL), alternatively known as 'Keeper League' or simply 'Keeper' was founded by Adam Worthington (now Coach and General Manager of the Vikings) in 2010.	The Ultimate Keeper League (UKL); is an "unincorporated not-for-profit association" which operates a major professional Fantasy Australian Rules Football Keeper League. Currently there are ten (10) franchised member clubs, nine (9) located in the Perth, Western Australia (including one (1) with dual-residence in London, England) and one (1) Located In New York City, United States of America (USA). Headquartered in Perth, Western Australia the UKL is widely considered to be the premier professional Fantasy Australian Rules Football Keeper League in Australia and one of the major professional Fantasy Keeper Leagues in the Universe. The youngest professional Fantasy Keeper League trophy in the southern hemisphere, the XXXXX, is awarded annually to the league champion at the end of each UKL Premiership Season.
1.2	Administration	The UKL Co-Commissioners for 2014 onwards are Adam Worthington and Chris Camporeale (hereby referred to collectively as the UKL Commissioner). The Deputy UKL Commissioner for 2014 onwards is Mark Lister. The UKL Treasurer for the 2014 season onwards is Andrew Owen. The UKL Rules and Regulations Administrator for the 2014 season onwards is Gavin Casey. The UKL Media Manager for the 2014 season onwards is Scott Cleaver.	The UKL was originally established with no official UKL Commissioner, however as the league was founded by Adam Worthington and a large majority of the administrative functions of the UKL have, since its establishment, been undertaken by Chris Camporeale (with assistance from Mark Lister) the obvious choice was to establish 'Co-Commissioner' Roles as of the adoption of these Rules and Regulations. The UKL Co-Commissioners shall each be known as 'His Lordship UKL Commissioner Wortho' and 'His Lordship UKL Commissioner Campo' or simply 'Wortho' and 'Campo' respectively. The Deputy UKL Commissioner will assume the roles and responsibilities of the UKL Commissioner in their absence, from time to time and as required. This includes, but is not limited to, the administrative functions of the league, clarification of player and team scoring, draft related duties and running of Official UKL events.
1.3	UKL Commissioner	The UKL Commissioner can only make decisions and directives in accordance with these rules and regulations. The UKL Commissioner may be required, from time to time to make decisions and directives, where an absolute majority cannot be reached on various matters in accordance with these Rules and Regulations.	The UKL Commissioner is responsible for the calendar of events during the pre-season (trade period, player retention and draft), administrative functions of the UKL website including but not limited to, player lists, trade notices, draft order, and any function required to ensure the smooth operation of the UKL Premiership Season. This to occur in a diligent and expedient manner (subject to other commitments). The UKL Commissioner may, at any time and without the formal approval of all UKL Coaches, delegate his administrative powers to, or seek assistance from the Deputy UKL Commissioner Mark Lister, or any other UKL Coach, as he sees fit. Said Deputy UKL Commissioner or UKL Coach, shall undertake these duties in accordance with

1.8		Any amendment to these Rules and Regulations must be in the best interests of the Operation of the UKL and must not be deemed to unfairly or unreasonably benefit an individual team or teams.
